RANGE SAFETY: NSRA rules apply. Uncased rifles must have either the bolt/action removed or a breech plug fitted at all times except when firing. (flags will be on sale at the meeting) Failure to observe these rules will lead to disqualification.

SQUADDING:- As there are a limited number of firing points, you are recommended to enter in advance. Entries may be taken on the day, space permitting so, to avoid disappointment, please enter early.

WMRA CUP: The final of this competition is shot as soon as possible after the last detail , around 4.00pm . This event is confined to members of clubs affiliated to the W&WSSBRA.

WEST SUSSEX CHAMPION: This is awarded to the top scoring competitor from the combined scores made in the WMRA Cup (long range) and the Dursley Cup (short range). If you were a finalist in the Dursley competition you are encouraged to enter the WMRA Open competition.
